SELECTION OF 4-H MEMBERS FOR STATE AND NATIONAL AWARDS

- 1. Age All state winners must be 14 to 18 years of age, as of January 1, of the current year.
- 2. Achievement Award Areas Beef, Citizenship & Community Service, Clothing & Textiles, Companion animals, Dairy, Dairy Goats, Environmental Sciences, Family Life & Child Development, Foods & Nutrition, Gardening & Horticulture, Health & Safety, Horse, Leadership, Meat Goats, Mechanical & Engineering Sciences, Personal Development, Photography, Rabbits & Poultry, Sheep, Shooting Sports, Swine, Veterinary Science, Woodworking.
- 3. Attendance at National 4-H Event state winners will attend National 4-H Congress.

National 4-H Dairy Conference

Ohio 4-H members 14 years of age and over are selected to attend the Dairy Conference held at Madison, Wisconsin, in October with emphasis on learning more about the dairy industry. To apply a member needs to fill out an Ohio 4-H Achievement Record with emphasis on dairy and submit it for both dairy and dairy conference awards.

State Junior Fair Board

Candidates must be at least 16 years old and not more than a sophomore in college and unmarried.

They need to fill out an Ohio 4-H Achievement Record with emphasis on leadership and experiences of being on a junior Fair board. One male and one female will be selected.

Ohio Dairy Goat Conference

The Ohio Dairy Goat Association sponsors 4 state winners to the Ohio Dairy Goat Conference annually. The purpose of the award is to provide recognition for outstanding 4-H members involved in the 4-H Dairy Goat program and to provide them with opportunities for further development of excellence in this subject matter.

OTA Local Government Award

One \$1,500 award for high school senior who has completed a local government activity with significant impact on applicant's community, township or county.
