OHIO 4-H SCHOLARSHIPS

Background and Purpose

In order to help young people continue their efforts toward becoming self-directing, productive, and contributing members of society, various 4-H program donors have established Ohio 4-H Scholarships which are awarded each year to deserving young adults.

Selection Procedures and Criteria

Applicants for the Ohio 4-H Scholarships must submit materials as specified on the [Ohio 4-H Scholarship Application](#) to the office. The winners of the scholarships are selected by the State 4-H Awards Selection Committee in late February. Criteria used in selections are:

4-H Leadership Activities	- 40%
Major 4H Honors	- 20%
4H Community Service/Citizenship	- 15%
Potential for Success	- 10%
Financial Need	- 10%
Personal Story	- 5%

The Awards and Their Presentations

The Ohio 4-H Scholarships to be awarded are listed as part of the Ohio 4-H Scholarship Application Form. Members should check all scholarships for which they are eligible.

Winners will be announced in the State 4-H Award Announcement letter to agents in early March and individual notification letters will be sent to applicants in April. The scholarships are presented to the winners at the Ohio 4-H Recognition program.
