Application Guidelines

Interest Sheet

You can sign up to assist with various county-wide leadership activities that will be held next year. Simply complete the enclosed Interest Sheet by January 5, 2020.

1 You must be a current 4-H member to apply for these opportunities unless it is noted for a particular activity.

2. Check the qualifications to apply for activities such as age and years of membership, etc.

3. Obtain all of the required signatures for your applications.

4. Meet deadlines!! If deadlines fall on a weekend or holiday, the applications must be postmarked on or before that day or delivered to the office on the next day we are open.

5. Copies of all applications are available at the office; we will give you as many copies as you need. **Please use only one form per person.**

6. All forms will be available from the office after December 1; unless otherwise noted.

Club Leadership

As a teen leader, it is important that you become active in your local 4-H club. Teen leaders serve as officers, committee chairs, mentors and much more. Talk to your advisors about your role in the club and how you can serve as a leader and role model to younger members. Be sure to enroll in a leadership project by April 15!

At times, we need to cancel meetings due to the weather. When cancellations are necessary, we will have an announcement on WCSM by 4:30 p.m. You can also call the office before 4:30 p.m. if in doubt. We also post cancellations on our website - auglaize.osu.edu/ and our Facebook page, Auglaize Co. 4-H.

4-H Committee Youth Representative

You might be interested in serving as a youth representative to the 4-H Advisory Committee. This committee helps set policy for the 4-H program, selects award winners and does fund raising for the program. There are two youth reps on the committee. Representatives are elected by the teens attending the 4-H banquet. If you think you might be interested, mark it on your Interest Sheet and we will send you more information. You must be 14 as of January 1, 2020.

County Awards Form

There is one county awards application to be used when applying for the following awards: Outstanding 4-H'er, Buckeye Leadership Workshop and Leadership Camp. You need to complete this application once each year. You simply mark all of the opportunities in which you are interested. Be sure to have an advisor complete the recommendation form. Make sure you meet the appropriate deadline and eligibility requirements. The form will either be due January 5 or March 1. A copy of the form is available from the office or online.

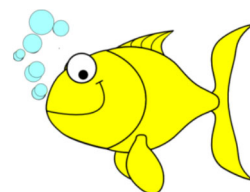
Outstanding 4-H'er

The title of Outstanding 4-H'er is the highest 4-H award in Auglaize County. Winners will be announced at the 4-H banquet in March. You must be at least 16 as of January 1, 2020 and have completed 6 years in 4-H. Use the county award application to apply. Due January 5, 2020.

Ohio 4-H Camps

Leadership Camp (June 1 - 5) is a great event to attend. This camp is held at Camp Ohio. Teens who are fourteen and over as of January 1 and have completed at least two years of 4-H are eligible to apply. If you are interested in applying you must submit a county awards application form. The form is due by March 1 for this opportunity. The 4-H Committee selects the winners.

Ohio 4-H Sea Camp will be held July 11-15 at Kelleys Island 4-H Camp. The camp is open to youth between 15-17 years of age (at the start of camp). Ohio 4-H Sea Camp offers teens an introduction to the Great Lakes through hands-on experiences in a variety of aquatic-based programs. Sea Camp will enable participants to experience Lake Erie activities and culture such as aquatic science, water recreation, and fishing. Niki Schaub Scholarship

The Niki Schaub 4-H Scholarship fund awards scholarships each year to a **current or former** Auglaize County 4-H members. It is available for any accredited school in any field of study. The scholarship is available to upperclassmen as well as incoming college freshman. If you have older siblings who are in college and out of 4-H, be sure they are aware of this scholarship too! Deadline to apply is June 1, 2020.

There are college scholarships available from the Auglaize Co. Junior Fair Boosters, Auglaize Co. Cattlemen's Association and the Junior Fair Horse Department also. Contact the scholarship sponsors for details.

Kids' Chef Schools

In the spring and fall of 2020, we will be looking for teens, 14 and older, to help with our Kids' Chef Schools. You will be helping younger members (2nd and 3rd graders) learn about cooking and nutrition and 4-H. You will help them play games, cook a meal and eat it! If this sounds like fun to you, sign up through the Junior Leader Interest Sheet.

Camp Counselor Applications

If you are interested in being a camp counselor or C.I.T. (counselor-in-training), you need to complete the enclosed application and return it by **January 1, 2020**. You must be at least **fifteen** as of January 1 to apply. Dates for camp are June 14-18, 2020 at 4-H Camp Palmer. Counselors and C.I.T.s will be selected through interviews to be held in January. A time schedule will be sent out to all applicants. The dates for counselor trainings are: January 30, February 13 & 25, March 10 & 24, April 7 & 23, May 5 & 21, June 9. **These trainings are required.** 4-H members, 9 through 15, as of January 1, will be eligible to register for camp as campers. Youth, who are 16 and over, must be selected as counselors or counselors-in-training to attend camp.



CARTEENS are teens who teach other teens about the importance of safe and responsible driving. The program is conducted in cooperation with the Auglaize County Juvenile Court. Teens, ages 15 and older, who are interested in reducing teen traffic offenses in Auglaize County, should apply. You must commit to attending a training session and be available to teach at the monthly meetings. CARTEENS is held the second Monday of every month at 7:00 p.m. Don Baumer serves as the coordinator. Applications are accepted throughout the year, a copy is enclosed.

State 4-H Happenings

Ohio 4-H Conference

This conference will be held Saturday, March 14 in Columbus. Cost is \$40. There are many sessions relating to 4-H, leadership, camp counseling and other teen issues. It is an excellent program. Registration and class information is available from the office. Deadline to register is February 1, 2020.

Achievement Awards

Teens, 14 and over, are eligible to complete an Ohio 4-H Achievement Record. This form is a complete record of your accomplishments throughout your 4-H career. It takes time to complete; allow plenty of time to do a good job. These forms compete at the state level. State winners in the awards program will receive a trip to a national 4-H events. The Achievement Record must also be completed if you are interested in: National Dairy Conference, Ohio Township Association Local Government Award, State Junior Fair Board, or the Ohio Dairy Goat Conference. Call if you want more information. Achievement Records are due to our office by January 5, 2020.

Buckeye Leadership Workshop

One or two youth, 16 and older, can be selected to attend Buckeye Leadership Workshop. BLW will be held March 25-29 at Recreation Unlimited in Delaware, Ohio. Tuition is available through the Eric Vogel Memorial Fund. Submit the county awards application to our office by January 5, 2020.

Ohio 4-H Scholarships

There are college 4-H scholarships for OSU students who are current or past 4-H members. Forms are online through ohio4-h.org. Tell your college friends!
